YARN

Deramores Vintage Chunky

(50% merino wool, 50% acrylic; 140m / 153yds per 100g ball)

Barley (007) **6** **6** **7**

YOU WILL ALSO NEED

- A pair of 6mm (UK4 / US10) knitting needles
- A set of 6mm (UK4 / US10) circular knitting needles, 80cm (32in) length for Bands only
- Stitch holder
- 3 Buttons
- 2 Stitch markers
- Yarn needle for sewing

TENSION

14 sts and 19 rows over 10cm / 4in in stocking stitch on 6mm needles

Note: Take time to check your tension to ensure the correct fit.

ABBREVIATIONS

PATTERN NOTES

Where only one number is given this applies to all sizes.

PATTERN

BACK

Cast on **70** (78:86) sts.

Row 1 (RS): (K2, P2) to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2 (WS): (P2, K2) to last 2 sts, P2.

These rows set 2x2 rib.

Rep rows 1 and 2 twice more.

Starting with a RS knit row, work straight in St st until piece measures **51** (53:55)cm / **20** (20¾:21¾)in ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. **60** (68:76) sts

Dec 1 st at **each end** of next **3** (5:7) rows, then on foll **3** (3:3) alt rows. **48** (52:56) sts

Cont straight in St st until armholes measures **19** (20:21)cm / **7½** (7¾:8¼)in ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Next row (RS): Cast off **5** (6:6) sts, **K7** (7:8), turn, leaving rem **35** (38:41) sts on a holder.

Next row (WS): Cast off 3 sts, P to end.

Next row (RS): Cast off rem **5** (5:6) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts left on holder, cast off **22** (24:26) sts, K to end.

Next row (WS): Cast off **5** (6:6) sts, P to end.

Next row (RS): Cast off 3 sts, K to end.

Next row (WS): Cast off rem **5** (5:6) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on **12** (14:16) sts.

Starting with a RS knit row, work 4 rows in St st.

Next row (RS): K to end, cast on **7** (8:9) sts at end of row. **19** (22:25) sts

Note: Please read this next section carefully as you will be working two sets of shaping instructions at the same time.

Cont in St st and at the same time shape hem as follows:

Cast on **4** (5:6) sts at end of next RS row, 3 sts at end of foll 2 RS rows, 2 sts at end of foll 2 RS rows, 1 st at end of foll 3 RS rows and **at the same time**, dec 1 st at side edge of last 3 rows. **33**

(37:41) sts

Next row (WS): K to end and dec 1 st at side edge. **32** (36:40) sts
Cont straight in St st until work measures **34** (36:38)cm / **13½** (14¼:15)in ending with a RS row.

Neck shaping

Next row (WS): Cast off **0** (1:3) sts, P to end.

Cast off 1 st at front edge every foll 4th row **12** (13:13) times and **at the same time** when work measures same as Back to armhole shaping, ending with a WS row, start shaping for armholes by casting off 5 sts at armhole edge. Dec 1 st at armhole edge on next **3** (5:7) rows, then dec at same edge on 2 foll alt rows until 10 sts rem.

Cont straight in St st until armhole measures **19** (20:21)cm / **7½** (7¾:8¼)in ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders

Next row (RS): Cast off 5 sts, K to end.

Next row (WS): Purl.

Cast off rem 5 sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 12 (14:16) sts.

Starting with a WS purl row, work 4 rows in St st.

Next row (WS): P to end, cast on 7 (8:9) sts at end of row. 19 (22:25) sts

Note: Please read this next section carefully as you will be working two sets of shaping instructions at the same time.

Cont in St st and at the same time shape hem as follows:

Cast on 4 (5:6) sts at end of next WS row, 3 sts at end of foll 2 WS rows, 2 sts at end of foll 2 WS rows, 1 st at end of foll 3 WS rows and **at the same time**, dec 1 st at side edge of last 3 rows. 33 (37:41) sts

Next row (RS): K to end and dec 1 st at side edge. 32 (36:40) sts

Cont straight in St st until work measures 34 (36:38)cm / 13½ (14¼:15)in ending with a WS row.

Neck shaping

Next row (RS): Cast off 0 (1:3) sts, K to end.

Cast off 1 st at front edge every foll 4th row 12 (13:13) times and **at the same time** when work measures same as Back to armhole shaping, ending with a RS row, start shaping for armholes by casting off 5 sts at armhole edge. Dec 1 st at armhole edge on next 3 (5:7) rows, then dec at same edge on 2 foll alt rows until 10 sts rem.

Cont straight in St st until armhole measures 19 (20:21)cm / 7½ (7¾:8¼)in ending with a RS row.

Shape shoulders

Next row (WS): Cast off 5 sts, P to end.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Cast off rem 5 sts.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Cast on 26 (28:30) sts.

Work 6 rows in 2x2 rib as for Back.

Note: For size 12/14 work [K2, P2] to end on both RS and WS rows.

Starting with a RS knit row, working in St st, inc 1 st at **each end** of all following rows 6 times. 38 (40:42) sts

Inc 1 st at **each end** of every foll 4th row 8 times. 54 (56:58) sts

Cont straight until sleeve measures 33 (38:43)cm / 13 (15:17)in, ending with a WS purl row.

Sleevehead

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 44 (46:48) sts

Dec 1 st at **each end** of next 5 rows. 34 (36:38) sts

Dec 1 st at **each end** of foll 1 (0:1) alt rows. 32 (36:36) sts

Dec 1 st at **each end** of next 5 (7:7) rows. 22 sts

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 14 sts

Cast off.

MAKING UP

Join shoulder seams.

Right band

Using circular needle, with RS facing and starting at Front side seam, pick up and K39 (42:44) sts along the curved edge, 87 (91:96) sts up Front edge to shoulder seam and 16 (17:18) sts to halfway across back of neck. 142 (150:158) sts

Next row (WS): P2, (K2, P2) to end. As you work this row, place a marker at the bottom of the front neck shaping, work in pattern for 26 sts, and place a second marker to indicate where to work the buttonholes in next row.

Buttonhole row (RS): Working in rib as set, work 3 buttonholes as follows: Rib to marker, remove marker, (yo, k2tog, rib 10) twice, yo, k2tog, remove marker, rib to end. 3 *buttonholes made*

Work 4 more rows in 2x2 rib.

Cast off in rib.

Left band

Using circular needles and with RS facing starting at back of left neck where the Right Band finished, pick up and K16 (17:18) sts along back of neck, 87 (91:96) sts down Front straight edge, and 39 (42:44) sts along curved edge towards side seam. 142 (150:158) sts

Next row (WS): P2, (K2, P2) to end.

Next row (RS): K2, (P2, K2) to end.

Work last 2 rows twice more.

Cast off in rib.

FINISHING

Join Back neckband seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Attach buttons in-line with buttonholes. See ballband for washing and further care instructions.



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Yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

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
