**Sirdar Simple Recycled DK 50g balls**

**Shade (Long Jacket)**

Greenhouse (014) 7 8 9 11 12 13 balls

**Shade (Short Jacket)**

Clay (013) 5 6 7 9 10 11 balls

**YOU WILL ALSO NEED**

- A pair of 3.25mm (UK10 / US3) knitting needles
- A pair of 4mm (UK8 / US6) knitting needles

**TENSION**

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm / 4in, over stocking stitch

**Note:** Take time to check your tension to ensure the correct fit.

**NOTES**

No stitch counts are given at the end of rows 3, 7, 11 or 15 of patt as sts reduce by 1 per hole on these rows.



**LONG JACKET BACK**

Using 3 1/4mm needles and thumb method cast on 118 [130:146:158:170:182] sts.

**1st Row:** K2, \* p2, k2, rep from \* to end.

**2nd Row:** \* P2, k2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **2x2 rib**.

Work 11 [11:11:15:15:15] rows more in 2x2 rib.

**For 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only**

**Next Row:** P8 [3:3:3:6], p2tog, (p3 [4:4:4:5], p2tog) 20 [23:25:27:24] times, p8

[3:3:3:6]. 97 [122:132:142:157] sts.

**For 2nd size only**

**Next Row:** (P5, p2tog) 9 times, p4, (p2tog, p5) 9 times. [112] sts.

**For all 6 sizes**

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row:** Knit.

**2nd Row:** Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

**3rd Row:** K1, yfwd, k1wy2rn, \* cast off 3 sts, yfwd, k1wy2rn, rep from \* to end.

**4th Row:** \* P1 dropping extra yarn, drop yfwd, purl into front, back, front and back of next st, rep from \* to last 4 sts, p1 dropping extra yarn, drop yfwd, p1. 5th to 18th Row: Rep 1st to 4th row 3 times more then 1st and 2nd rows again.

**19th to 22nd Row:** Purl.

**23rd to 36th Row:** Work 14 rows in st-st.

**37th to 40th Row:** Purl. From 1st to 40th row sets patt. \*\*

Keeping continuity of patt (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 70 [70:72:74:80:80] rows more.

### Shape Sleeves

Cast on 10 [10:10:15:15:15] sts at end of next 2 rows. 117 [132:142:162:172:187] sts. Work 52 [56:62:68:70:74] rows without shaping.

### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 3 [4:3:4:4:4] sts in patt at beg of next 2 [2:4:14:10:2] rows. 111 [124:130:106:132:179] sts.

### For 1st, 2nd and 5th sizes only

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:4] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k4 [8:7], patt to last 7 [6:5] sts, k7 [6:5].

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:4] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p7 [6:5], patt to last 1 [4:3] sts, p1 [4:3]. 105 [116:124] sts.

Cast off 3 [4:4] sts in patt at beg of next 2 rows. 99 [108:116] sts.

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:5] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k8 [5:9], patt to last 6 [8:7] sts, k6 [8:7].

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:5] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p6 [8:7], patt to last 5 [1:4] sts, p5 [1:4]. 93 [100:106] sts.

### For 1st, 2nd, 4th and 6th sizes only

Cast off 3 [4:5:5] sts in patt at beg of next 2 [12:2:2] rows. 87 [52:96:169] sts.

### For 1st size only

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k7, patt to last 5 sts, k5.

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p5, patt to last 3 sts, p3. 79 sts.

### For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Cast off 5 sts in patt at beg of next 2 rows. [86:96:159] sts.

**Next Row:** Cast off 5 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k [9:9:8], patt to last [7:7:6] sts, k7 [7:6].

**Next Row:** Cast off 5 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p [7:7:6], patt to last [4:4:3] sts, p [4:4:3]. [76:86:149] sts.

Rep last 4 rows [1:1:3] times more. [56:66:89] sts.

### For all 6 sizes

Cast off 4 [5:4:5:5:5] sts in patt at beg of next 10 [2:22:2:4:8] rows. 39 [42:42:46:46:49] sts.

### For 1st, 2nd, 5th and 6th sizes only

Cast off rem 39 [42:46:49] sts in patt.

### For 3rd and 4th sizes only

Cast off rem [42:46] sts knit-ways.

### LEFT FRONT

Using 3 1/4mm needles and thumb method cast on 35 [39:47:51:59:63] sts.

**1st Row:** \* K2, p2, rep from \* to last 3 sts, k2, p1.

**2nd Row:** K1, p2, \* k2, p2, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows set rib.

Work 11 [11:11:15:15:15] rows more in rib.

**Next Row:** P4 [2:2:4:4:3], p2tog, (p3 [9:5:4:3:5], p2tog) 5 [3:6:7:10:8] times, p4 [2:1:3:3:2]. 29 [35:40:43:48:54] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row:** Knit.

**2nd Row:** Purl.

**3rd Row:** K1, yfwd, k1wy2rn, \* cast off 3 sts, yfwd, k1wy2rn, rep from \* to last 2 [3:3:1:1:2] sts, k2 [3:3:1:1:2].

**4th Row:** P2 [3:3:1:1:2], \* p1 dropping extra yarn, drop yfwd, purl into front, back, front and back of next st, rep from \* to last 4 sts, p1 dropping extra yarn, drop yfwd, p1.

**5th to 18th Row:** Rep 1st to 4th row 3 times more then 1st and 2nd rows again.

**19th to 22nd Row:** Purl.

**23rd to 36th Row:** Work 14 rows in st-st.

**37th to 40th Row:** Purl.

From 1st to 40th row sets patt. \*\*

Keeping continuity of patt (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 71 [71:73:75:81:81] rows more.

### Shape Sleeve

**Next Row:** Patt to end, cast on 10 [10:10:15:15:15] sts. 39 [45:50:58:63:69] sts.

Work 52 [56:62:68:70:74] rows without shaping.

### Shape Shoulder

Work 2 [2:4:14:10:2] rows casting off 3 [4:3:4:4:4] sts in patt at beg of next and every foll 0 [0:2nd:2nd:2nd:0] row: 36 [41:44:30:43:65] sts.

### For 1st, 2nd and 5th sizes only

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:4] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k4 [8:7], patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 1 [4:3] sts, p1 [4:3]. 33 [37:39] sts.

Work 2 rows casting off 3 [4:4] sts in patt at beg of 1st row: 30 [33:35] sts.

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:5] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k8 [5:9], patt end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 5 [1:4] sts, p5 [1:4]. 27 [29:30] sts.

**For 1st, 2nd, 4th and 6th sizes only**

Work 2 [12:2:2] rows casting off 3 [4:5:5] sts in patt at beg of next and every foll 0 [2nd:0:0] row. 24 [5:25:60] sts.

**For 1st size only**

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k7, patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 3 sts, p3. 20 sts.

**For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only**

Work 2 rows casting off 5 sts in patt at beg of 1st row. [20:25:55] sts.

**Next Row:** Cast off 5 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k [9:9:8], patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last [4:4:3] sts, p [4:4:3]. [15:20:50] sts. Rep last 4 rows [1:1:3] times more. [5:10:20] sts.

**For 1st, 3rd, 5th and 6th sizes only**

Work 8 [20:2:6] rows casting off 4 [4:5:5] sts in patt at beg of next and every foll 2nd [2nd:0:2nd] row. 4 [4:5:5] sts.

**For all 6 sizes**

Cast off rem 4 [5:4:5:5:5] sts in patt.

**RIGHT FRONT**

Using 3 1/4mm needles and thumb method cast on 35 [39:47:51:59:63] sts.

**1st Row:** P1, \* k2, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**2nd Row:** P2, \* k2, p2, rep from \* to last st, k1.

These 2 rows set rib.

Work 11 [11:11:15:15:15] rows more in rib.

**Next Row:** P4 [2:1:3:3:2], (p2tog, p3 [9:5:4:3:5]) 5 [3:6:7:10:8] times, p2tog, p4 [2:2:4:4:3]. 29 [35:40:43:48:54] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row:** Knit.

**2nd Row:** Purl.

**3rd Row:** K4 [5:5:3:3:4], \* cast off 3 sts, yfwd, k1wy2rn, rep from \* to end.

**4th Row:** \* P1 dropping extra yarn, drop yfwd, purl into front, back, front and back of next st, rep from \* to last 4 [5:5:3:3:4] sts, p4 [5:5:3:3:4].

**5th to 18th Row:** Rep 1st to 4th row 3 times more then 1st and 2nd rows again.

**19th to 22nd Row:** Purl.

**23rd to 36th Row:** Work 14 rows in st-st.

**37th to 40th Row:** Purl. From 1st to 40th row sets patt. \*\*

Keeping continuity of patt (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 70 [70:72:74:80:80] rows more.

**Shape Sleeve**

**Next Row:** Patt to end, cast on 10 [10:10:15:15:15] sts. 39 [45:50:58:63:69] sts.

Work 53 [57:63:69:71:75] rows without shaping.

**Shape Shoulder**

Work 2 [2:4:14:10:2] rows casting off 3 [4:3:4:4:4] sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll 0 [0:2nd:2nd:2nd:0] row. 36 [41:44:30:43:65] sts.

For 1st, 2nd and 5th sizes only  
**Next Row:** Patt to last 7 [6:5] sts, k7 [6:5].

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:4] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p7 [6:5], patt to end. 33 [37:39] sts.

Work 2 rows casting off 3 [4:4] sts in patt at beg of 2nd row: 30 [33:35] sts.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 6 [8:7] sts, k6 [8:7].

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [4:5] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p6 [8:7], patt to end. 27 [29:30] sts.

**For 1st, 2nd, 4th and 6th sizes only**

Work 2 [12:2:2] rows casting off 3 [4:5:5] sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll 0 [2nd:0:0] row. 24 [5:25:60] sts.

**For 1st size only**

**Next Row:** Patt to last 5 sts, k5.

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p5, patt to end. 20 sts.

**For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only**

Work 2 rows casting off 5 sts in patt at beg of 2nd row. [20:25:55] sts.

**Next Row:** Patt to last [7:7:6] sts, k7 [7:6].

**Next Row:** Cast off 5 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p [7:7:6], patt to end. [15:20:50] sts.

Rep last 4 rows [1:1:3] times more. [5:10:20] sts.

**For 1st, 3rd, 5th and 6th sizes only**

Work 8 [20:2:6] rows casting off 4 [4:5:5] sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll 2nd [2nd:0:2nd] row. 4 [4:5:5] sts.

**For all 6 sizes**

**Next Row:** Patt.

Cast off rem 4 [5:4:5:5:5] sts in patt.

**RIGHT FRONT BORDER**

Join shoulder seams.

With rs facing, using 3 1/4mm needles pick up and knit 13 [13:13:15:15:15] sts evenly along rib, 169

[176:184:192:204:206] sts evenly along front edge and 20 [21:21:23:23:25] sts to centre

back of neck.  
202 [210:218:230:242:246] sts.  
Starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib  
work 13 [13:13:17:17:17] rows.  
Cast off in rib.

### LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using 3 1/4mm  
needles and starting at centre  
back of neck, pick up and knit 20  
[21:21:23:23:25] sts from back  
of neck,  
169 [176:184:192:204:206] sts  
evenly along front edge and 13  
[13:13:15:15:15] sts evenly  
along rib.  
202 [210:218:230:242:246] sts.  
Starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib  
work 13 [13:13:17:17:17] rows.  
Cast off in rib.

### SLEEVE EDGINGS (Both alike)

With rs facing, using 3 1/4mm  
needles pick up and knit  
98 [110:118:130:134:142] sts  
evenly all round sleeve edge.  
Starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib  
work 13 rows.  
Cast off in rib.

### TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams.  
Join border seam at centre back  
of neck. Pin out garment to the  
measurement given. Cover with  
damp cloths and leave until dry.  
See ball band for washing and  
further care instructions.

Work as given for Back of Long  
Jacket to \*\*.  
Keeping continuity of patt  
(throughout) proceed as  
follows:-  
Work 14 [14:16:18:24:24] rows  
more.

#### Shape Sleeves

Cast on 10 [10:10:15:15:15] sts  
at end of next 2 rows. 117

[132:142:162:172:187] sts.  
Work 52 [56:62:68:70:74] rows  
without shaping.

#### Shape Shoulders

##### For 1st and 6th sizes only

Cast off 3 [4] sts in patt at beg of  
next 10 [2] rows. 87 [179] sts.

##### For all 6 sizes

Cast off 4 [4:3:4:4:5] sts in patt  
at beg of next 4 [10:2:2:14:20]  
rows. 71 [92:136:154:116:79]  
sts.

##### For 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 6th sizes only

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 [4:3:4:5]  
sts at beg of row working across  
row as follows:- k9 [7:4:8:8],  
patt to last 7 [5:7:6:6] sts,  
k7 [5:7:6:6].

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 [4:3:4:5]  
sts at beg of row working across  
row as follows:- p7 [5:7:6:6], patt

Cast off 4 sts in patt at beg of  
next 2 rows. [60:106] sts.  
Next Row: Cast off 4 sts at beg  
of row working across row as  
follows:- k [6:9], patt to last [9:7]  
sts, k [9:7].  
**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg  
of row working across row as  
follows:- p [9:7], patt to last [2:5]  
sts, p [2:5]. [52:98] sts.

Cast off 4 sts in patt at beg of  
next 2 rows. [90] sts.

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg  
of row working across row as  
follows:- p9, patt to last 2 sts,  
p2. [82] sts.

Cast off 4 sts in patt at beg of  
next 6 rows. [106] sts.

#### For 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only

Cast off 4 [5:4:5:5] sts in patt at  
beg of next 2 [2:10:12:12] rows.  
39 [42:42:46:56] sts.

### For 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 6th sizes only

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 [4:3:4:5] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k9 [7:4:8:8], patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 5 [3:1:4:3] sts, p5 [3:1:4:3]. 12 [21:44:50:10] sts.

Work 2 rows casting off 4 [4:4:4:5] sts in patt at beg of next row. 8 [17:40:46:5] sts.

### For 2nd and 3rd sizes only

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k [9:7], patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last [5:3] sts, p [5:3]. [13:36] sts.

Work 2 rows casting off 4 sts in patt at beg of next row. [9:32] sts.

### For 3rd size only

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k9, patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 5 sts, p5. [28] sts.

Work 2 rows casting off 4 sts in patt at beg of next row. [24] sts.

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k6, patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 2 sts, p2. [20] sts.

### For 4th size only

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k5, patt to end.

**Next Row:** Patt to last st, p1. [42] sts.

Work 6 rows casting off 4 sts in patt at beg of next and every foll alt row. [30] sts.

### For 1st, and 2nd sizes only

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- k6, patt 2 [3].

**Next Row:** Patt 2 [3], p2. 4 [5] sts.

### For 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only

Work [8:10:12] rows casting off [4:5:5] sts in patt at beg of next and every foll alt row. [4:5:5] sts.

### For all 6 sizes

Cast off rem 4 [5:4:5:5:5] sts knitways.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work as given for Right Front of Long Jacket to \*\*.

Keeping continuity of patt (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 14 [14:16:18:24:24] rows more.

## Shape Sleeve

**Next Row:** Patt to end, cast on 10 [10:10:15:15:15] sts.

39 [45:50:58:63:69] sts.

Work 53 [57:63:69:71:75] rows without shaping.

## Shape Shoulder

### For 1st and 6th sizes only

Work 10 [2] rows casting off 3 [4] sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll 2nd [0] row.

24 [65] sts.

### For all 6 sizes

Work 4 [10:2:2:14:20] rows casting off 4 [4:3:4:4:5] sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll

2nd [2nd:0:0:2nd:2nd] row. 16 [25:47:54:35:15] sts.

### For 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 6th sizes only

**Next Row:** Patt to last

7 [5:7:6:6] sts, k7 [5:7:6:6].

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 [4:3:4:5] sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p7 [5:7:6:6], patt to end.

12 [21:44:50:10] sts.

Work 2 rows casting off 4 [4:4:4:5] sts in patt at beg of 2nd row: 8 [17:40:46:5] sts.

### For 2nd, 3rd and 4th sizes only

**Next Row:** Patt to last [7:5:8] sts, k [7:5:8].

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p [7:5:8], patt to end. [13:36:42] sts.

Work [2:2:6] rows casting off 4 sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll [0:0:2nd] row. [9:32:30] sts.

### For 3rd size only

**Next Row:** Patt to last 7 sts, k7.

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p7, patt to end. [28] sts.

Work 2 rows casting off 4 sts in patt at beg of 2nd row. [24] sts.

**Next Row:** Patt to last 9 sts, k9.

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts at beg of row working across row as follows:- p9, patt to end. [20] sts.

### For 1st and 2nd sizes only

**Next Row:** Knit.

**Next Row:** Cast off 4 sts purlways, purl to end. 4 [5] sts.

**Next Row:** Patt.

### For 3rd and 4th sizes only

Work [8:10] rows casting off [4:5] sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll alt row. [4:5] sts.

**Next Row:** Patt.

### For 5th size only

Work 12 rows casting off 5 sts in patt at beg of 2nd and every foll alt row. [5] sts.

### For 5th and 6th sizes only

**Next Row:** Knit.

### For all 6 sizes

Cast off rem 4 [5:4:5:5:5] sts purlways.

### RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, using 3 1/4mm needles pick up and knit 13 [13:13:15:15:15] sts evenly along rib, 117 [124:132:140:152:154] sts evenly along front edge and 20 [21:21:23:23:25] sts to centre back of neck. 150 [158:166:178:190:194] sts. Starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib work 13 [13:13:17:17:17] rows. Cast off in rib.

### LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using 3 1/4mm needles and starting at centre back of neck, pick up and knit 20 [21:21:23:23:25] sts from back of neck, 117 [124:132:140:152:154] sts evenly along front edge and 13 [13:13:15:15:15] sts evenly along rib. 150 [158:166:178:190:194] sts. Starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib work 13 [13:13:17:17:17] rows. Cast off in rib.

### SLEEVE EDGINGS (Both alike)

Work as given for Sleeve Edgings of Long Jacket.

### TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams. Join border seam at centre back of neck. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
