YOU WILL ALSO NEED

- A pair of 3mm (UK11 / US) knitting needles
- A pair of 3.5mm (UK / US 4) knitting needles

TENSION

28sts and 34 rows to 10cm / 4in square, over farrow rib using 3.5mm needles.

Note: Take time to check your tension to ensure the correct fit.



BACK

Using 3mm needles and SABLE, cast on a) 131 - b) 137 - c) 149 - d) 161 e) 173 sts and work in k1, p2 rib for 5 cm, beg and end 1st row and foll alt rows (RS) with p2.

Change to 3.5mm needles and farrow rib (see STITCHES and chart), beg with 1 selv st and 3rd st in chart. When work meas 39cm after rib, cont in INDIGO on a) b) 33 - c) 39 - d) 42 e) 45 outer sts.

[a) 65 - b) 71 - c) 71 - d) 77 - e) 83 sts in SABLE at center of work]

When work meas 43cm after rib, shape armholes. On each edge, cast off: a) b) 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times - c) 5 sts once,

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times - d) e) 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times. [a) 99 - b) 105 - c) 111 - d) 117 e) 129 sts1

When work meas a) 63 - b) 64 - c) 65 d) 66 - e) 67 cm after rib, shape shoulders.

On each edge, cast off: a) 5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once - b) 5 sts once and 6 sts 3 times - c) 6 sts twice and 7 sts twice - d) 7 sts 4 times - e) 8 sts twice and 9 sts twice.

At the same time, shape neck. Cast off a) 17 - b) c) 19 - d) e) 21 center sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On neck edge, cast off 10 sts twice. Finish other side of neck in same way.

FRONT

Work as for Back.

When work meas a) 57-b) 58-c) 59-d) 60-e) 61 cm after rib, shape neck. Cast off a) 15- b) c) 17- d) e) 19 center sts, then cont on 1 side at a time. On neck edge, cast off 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 5 times. When work meas a) 63 - b) 64 - c) 65 d) 66 - e) 67 cm after rib, shape shoulder.

On armhole edge, cast off: a) 5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once - b) 5 sts once and 6 sts 3 times - c) 6 sts twice and 7 sts twice - d) 7 sts 4 times - e) 8 sts twice and 9 sts twice.

Finish other side of neck in same way.

SLEEVES

Using 3mm needles and SABLE, cast on a) 65 - b) 71 - c) 77 - d) 83 - e) 89 sts and work in k1, p2 rib for 5 cm, beg and end 1st row and foll alt rows (RS) with p2.

Change to 3.5mm needles and farrow rib (see STITCHES and chart), beg with 1 selv st and 3rd st in chart. Inc on each edge (keep farrow rib

correct): on foll 10th rows, inc 1 st 10 times, on foll 8th rows, inc 1 st 6 times. [a) 97 - b) 103 - c) 109 - d) 115 e) 121 sts]

Note: meanwhile, when work meas 42 cm after rib, cont in INDIGO. When work meas 46cm after rib, shape slope.

On each edge, cast off: a) 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice, 1 st 18 times, 2 sts 3 times and 3 sts once - b) 3 sts 3 times, 2 sts twice, 1 st 17 times, 2 sts twice and 3 sts twice - c) 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times, 1 st 15 times, 2 sts 3 times and 3 sts twice - d) 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times, 1 st 14 times, 2 sts 3 times, 3 sts twice and 4 sts once-e) 4 sts once, 3 sts 3 times, 2 sts 3 times, 1 st 12 times, 2 sts 4 times, 3 sts twice and 4 sts once.

When work meas 61cm after rib, cast off rem 23 sts.

Work other sleeve in same way.

NECKBAND


Using 3mm needles and SABLE, cast on a) 144 - b) c) 150 - d) e) 156 sts and work in k1,p1 rib for 3 cm, then knit 1 row (RS) and several rows of st st in a different color.


Iron these rows, then simply unravel back to base color when making up.

MAKE UP

Sew various seams. Join sleeves to body.

Sew neckband, matching sts and using backstitch on right side of work.

Farrow rib: (also see chart)

Number of sts for symmetry: multiple of 3 + 1 + 1 selv st on each edge 1st row (RS): 1 selv st, *k2, p1*, repeat from *to *, end with k1, 1 selv

2nd row: 1 selv st, p1, *k2, p1*, repeat from * to *, end with 1 selv st. These 2 rows form pattern.

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
